Harvey Konigsberg is a New Yorker who began his career as a fine artist in 1964. The following year, he began studying Aikido with Yamada Sensei at the New York Aikikai. He has devoted himself to these two disciplines, since that time. What makes Harvey Sensei a great teacher? Just as a fine painter communicates so much meaning with simple brush-strokes, Sensei Harvey transmits so much of the essence of aikido with simple, elegant movements.
